Note:

- 1. There will be negative marking of 0.25 marks from the marks allotted for that particular question
- 2. Cutoff marks will be decided on the basis of Average
- 3. CWE Score will be available on IBPS Website.
- 4. Score card will be valid for one year from the date of issuing it.
- 5. CWE would be conducted at many centres as given in the notification.
- 6. Pre examination training will be provided for limited number of candidates for which online application has to be made.

Common Interview: Candidates who will qualify Online examination will subsequently called for a Common Interview conducted by the Nodal Regional Rural Bank in each State/ UT, coordinated by IBPS. The total marks allotted for Interview are 100. The minimum qualifying marks/ scores in interview and within it for local language proficiency will not be less than 40% (35% for SC/ ST candidates). The minimum qualifying marks in interview for Officer Scale II & III will also be not less than 40% for all the candidates except 35% for SC/ ST candidates. The relative weightage (ratio) of CWE and interview will be 70:30 respectively. Candidates should qualify both in the CWE and interview and be sufficiently high in the merit to be shortlisted for subsequent provisional allotment process.
