

West Bengal Sub Inspector Eligibility Details: West Bengal Police Sub-Inspector (Armed, Unarmed) Eligibility Details are given below...

Eligibility:

Nationality: Must be a citizen of India.

Age: The candidates must not be less than 20 years and not more than 27 years. Upper Age limit is relaxable by 5 years for SC/ST and d by 3 years for OBC candidates of West Bengal only. Upper age limit is also relaxable upto 35 years for departmental candidates of West Bengal Police having requisite qualification.

Educational Qualification: A degree of a recognized university or its equivalent.
